CLEET Phase 4 “Basic Firearms Training”

REQUIREMENTS OF THE COURSE

Effective Immediately - All Students Enrolled In Cleet Phase 4 That Need To Reschedule Their Phase 4 Class MUST DO SO AT LEAST FIVE (5) DAYS Prior To The Course Date. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN A COMPLETE LOSS OF TUITION AND A FEE OF \$75.00 IN ORDER TO ATTEND THE FOLLOWING MONTH'S PHASE 4. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTION - NOT EVEN PROGRAM MEMBERS, SO BE SURE OF YOUR “INTENT TO ATTEND” DATES

MMPI or CPI:

A personality profile **MUST** be completed successfully **BEFORE** the first (1st) day of the class. You may use any psychologist you wish as long as they use the proper CLEET form. This Testing is now conducted at the SOR facility at a cost of \$125.00, check the “Monthly Course Schedules” for the dates and times.

EQUIPMENT:

Each student must have the following equipment in order to complete the Phase 4 course:

- A semi-automatic pistol (9mm to .45 cal) or a six (6) shot double action revolver, .38 caliber, barrel length recommended 2-4 inches (6 in. is accepted)
- A holster, with a retention system of some kind that fits your handgun. Holster **MUST** be affixed to a belt. Paddle holsters, Shoulder holsters or Tactical leg holsters are not allowed.
- At least **three (3) magazines** for a Semi-automatic pistol or two (2) speed-loaders for your revolver and a magazine or speed-loader pouch. Students must also furnish a belt to hold all of the above equipment in place around your waist, even if it's just a pants belt.
- Baseball cap to be worn **only** on the Firing Range.
- Students must provide their own ear and eye protection.

Weapons By The Following Manufacturers Are Not Allowed On Our Range:

JENNINGS, JIMINEZ, LORSEN, RG, RAVEN, HIGHPOINT, TIGER, or SCCY

AMMUNITION: NO ALUMINUM or STEEL CASED OR WOLF Brand AMMUNITION. INSIST ON THE FOLLOWING AMMO NO MATTER WHAT THE STORE CLERK MAY TRY TO SELL YOU, THE BULLETS MUST HAVE A COPPER COVERED NOSE AND BRASS SHELL CASE, WHICH MEANS THAT ABSOLUTELY NO LEAD IS VISIBLE. Each student must have **400 rounds** (in the caliber of your weapon), of **FULL METAL JACKET (FMJ)**, factory issue ammunition. **Absolutely NO Remanufactured or reloaded bullets are allowed in this or any shooting course. NO SOFT NOSE or EXPOSED LEAD BULLETS.** This ammunition may be purchased anywhere, including the following places:
